


PLATINUM JUBILEE **CELEBRATIONS**

Shortly after the elections, the first major event to be held in Westhill was the celebration of the platinum jubilee of HM Queen Elizabeth II, a feat achieved by no other monarch in British history.

The Rotary Club organised a fantastic Sunday afternoon party which Ron & Craig were delighted to attend, together with local MP Andrew Bowie. The attendance numbers demonstrated the importance of this celebration to the local community.

Congratulations to Westhill & Elrick Community Council who successfully petitioned the council to have the A944



between the 6-mile fork and the Tesco roundabout renamed as "Jubilee Drive" in recognition of Her Majesty's achievement.

DANGEROUS DRIVING

Concerns continue to be raised in the outlying villages about excessive speed, particularly Dunecht & Echt.

Dunecht residents have been working effectively with the police and primary school to highlight the dangers this poses to pedestrians, and have in fact pulled drivers over and allowed the school children to question them.

A recent survey recorded 96 mph as the highest speed recorded through Dunecht clearly this is unacceptable and Ron & Craig are working with residents to ensure a safer environment on our ruralroads.

GREEN OPEN SPACES

Ron & Craig are currently supporting the application for funding made by Westhill & **Elrick Community Council to** enhance the open spaces at Denman Park, Arnhall Moss and Carnie Woods.

These green spaces are precious to the local community and indeed promote well being and nature watching right in the heart of Westhill. The proposals include improving the walkways, (particularly in Carnie Woods), and improved

linkage to existing paths through Arnhall Moss and Denman Park, linking these areas directly to other public walkways around the area.

Ron & Craig are also happy to continue supporting the use of other leisure amenities in Westhill such as the well utilised swimming pool and the football and rugby parks at Westdyke and Lawsondale.



WESTHILL PHARMACY SERVICES

A recurring issue for a considerable period has been complaints about the pharmacy service in Westhill.

The community council heard a presentation of a proposal to build a third pharmacy in Westhill by Porter's Pharmacy but this was withdrawn after an approach was made to buy the existing pharmacies instead. This took place in December 2022 and the pharmacies are now operating under new management. The improvements in the service have been well received by residents.

Ron & Craig have both met with the new owners and will support them in any way they can and we wish them well in their new endeavour
